Locations: Tasmania (Hobart), South Australia (Adelaide), New Zealand, ACT (Canberra), Western Australia (Perth), New South Wales (Newcastle)

Position Description:

As team leader you will be responsible for liaising directly with ASSBI's student coordinator to update them on your team's progress. As team leader, you will be responsible for bringing together your team of student ambassadors from your city/state and running regular meetings (advised quarterly) where you plan as a group your proposed action to help promote ASSBI to your wider networks. It is expected that all team members, including the team leader, are responsible for this active promotion. This may be through a number of different mediums, such as presenting at conferences/seminars/lectures, distributing flyers to student communities and/or advertising on social media. You will also be expected to organise with your team at least two student ASSBI events per year (e.g., speaker, quiz night, pub night, movie night, social event) where students are invited to attend and encouraged to participate and learn more about ASSBI. The student coordinator will support you with providing ideas as to how best to run these types of events.

Position Description:

As a student ambassador you will work together with fellow student ambassadors who represent a range of disciplines (e.g. psychology, speech pathology, occupational therapy, neuropsychology) to help promote ASSBI to your wider student networks.
